- Promise to Abraham
 - Genesis 12:2-3
 - Galatians 3:7-9
 - Save the whole world – not just Israel!
 - Israel is God's chosen people set aside for a specific purpose.
 - THE LAW was given to Israel to fulfill this specific purpose.
 - Ceremonial – Laws related to Israel's worship
 - Civil – Dictated Israel's daily living as a nation state
 - Moral – Direct commands of God. They reveal the nature and will of God and still apply to us today
